

APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO KEEP PETROLEUM SPIRIT

Note: The term "petroleum spirit" must in every case be taken to include the term "petroleum mixtures" as defined in Note (a) below.

for a Licence under the Petroleum (Regulation) Acts 1928 and 1936, to keep Petroleum Spirit on the premises of which particulars are given below, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts and subject to such conditions as the Local Authority may from time to time prescribe.

1. Name and address of premises where the Petroleum Spirit is to be kept or stored	
2. Nature of business carried on at the premises

4. Maximum Quantity of Petroleum Spirit proposed to be kept at any one time, specifying separately the quantities of spirit and each individual type of mixture	
5. Mode of Storage, including description and materials of receptacles and storehouse or tank, distance of store from nearest dwelling and/or other building	
6. Is it proposed to sell Petroleum Spirit to the public?

NOTES:

- (a) "Petroleum Mixtures" means all mixtures (whether liquid, viscous or solid) of petroleum with any other substance except mixtures which, when tested in the manner set forth in the Petroleum (Mixtures) Order 1929 do not give off an inflammable vapour at a temperature below 73 degrees Fahrenheit.
- (b) Scale of Fees payable for a 1 / 2 / 3 year renewal period to the Local Authority by the person or persons to whom a licence is granted to keep Petroleum Spirit, as fixed by the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act 1928, First Schedule, as amended by the Petroleum (Regulation) Acts 1928 and 1936 (Fees) Regulations 1981.

In respect of a licence to keep a quantity:-

Not exceeding 2,500 litres	£41.00	£82.00	£123.00
Exceeding 2,500 litres, not exceeding 50,000 litres	£57.00	£114.00	£171.00
Exceeding 50,000 litres	£118.00	£236.00	£354.00

In the case of solid Mixtures of Petroleum, 1 kilogram is to be regarded as the equivalent of one litre.
